Programme Overview

The International Skills Training (IST) – Courses have been developed with Australian TVET expertise and are licensed by the Australian Government for delivery by quality Australian Registered Training Organisations (RTOs). Melbourne Polytechnic is currently licensed to deliver IST courses. Melbourne Polytechnic can meet the needs by providing IST through a cost-effective, sustainable delivery model. Melbourne Polytechnic will provide a trainer to deliver for TVET TTT Trainer Course and TVET Assessor Course in Malaysia. The training will be conducted in English by a qualified and experienced Melbourne Polytechnic trainer.

The International Skills Training (IST) courses were launched as a new Australian Government initiative in April 2017. This initiative will oversee the delivery of training courses specifically designed and developed for the offshore international student market. These courses aim to address critical competency gaps, support global skills needs in the global workforce, and provide Australian registered training organisations (RTOs) the opportunity to offer additional products to support overseas stakeholders to meet their diverse skills needs. TVETC002 - TVET Assessor

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Programme Details

The international training and assessment courses are designed to assist in building capacity of trainers and assessors; a key foundation of any successful training system.

TVETC001 - TVET Trainer Course provides learners with a vocational background the skills to train learners in their industry of expertise. Appropriately skilled trainers have the confidence and capacity to make reasoned judgments when training, including adapting teaching materials and learning techniques to meet industry and learner needs.

TVETC002 - TVET Assessor Course provides learners with a vocational background the skills to assess learners in their industry of expertise. Skilled assessors will help to meet the needs of industry and enterprises through assessing learners' skills and knowledge for the workplace.

Entry requirements : Those entering this program must be able to demonstrate vocational competency in the industry area where they will be training. Vocational competency is defined as broad industry knowledge and experience, and may include, but is not limited to, industry experience or holding relevant qualifications.

Certification

Learners who successfully complete a course will be awarded a completion certificate carrying the Australian Government crest and the Australia Future Unlimited brand. The Australian Government is working with national governments and relevant organisations to support recognition of the courses internationally.

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
